FLORA NATAPOFF: PAINTINGS

Flora Natapoff belongs to no movement. Her blend of realism, emphasis on pictorial stroke and use of spatial juxtaposition attempt to convey both contemporary urban experience and her own sensibility. The spatial progress through the city comes from film, Chinese scroll painting and Pollock's friezes. Thematically the parallelism between Hackney — her home for the past three years — and her childhood experience (born in Brooklyn, New York, fifty years ago) elicits an interplay between the city and the pictorial structure which carries for her implicit psychological and political metaphor.

Never before exhibited, Flora Natapoff's recent, kaleidoscopic, work on paper fills the whole of the foyer area.
